Numeracy: Children have opportunities to use data to analyse real life situations. They are able to apply reasoning skills and compile evidence to form conclusions. Drawing climate graphs and interpreting data are routinely taught in all country specific topics. Numeracy is used to compliment the Geography learning intentions and answer the big questions.

Literacy: All topics in Geography have a literacy focus and a final piece of extended writing in order to apply their English skills and knowledge of different styles of writing. Children are given appropriate amounts of time to research, draft, write and re-write final pieces. The main focus is on explaining and evidencing points in all written work as well as commenting verbally to layered questioning.
